From the very beginning of our company, we decided our corporation would actively take part in the many opportunities providing help for those in need.

In 1973, a group of community volunteers opened Union Station as a simple hospitality center to serve poor and homeless men in downtown Pasadena. Today, Union Station is the San Gabriel Valley's largest and most comprehensive social service agency assisting homeless and very low-income people.

Our mission is to help men, women and children rebuild their lives and help put an end to homelessness.

Union Station operates five programs to help homeless adults and families achieve self-sufficiency:

The 56-bed Adult Center provides men and women with safe, substance free shelter, meals and supportive services. The Adult Center is also home to our Community Meals and Shower programs.

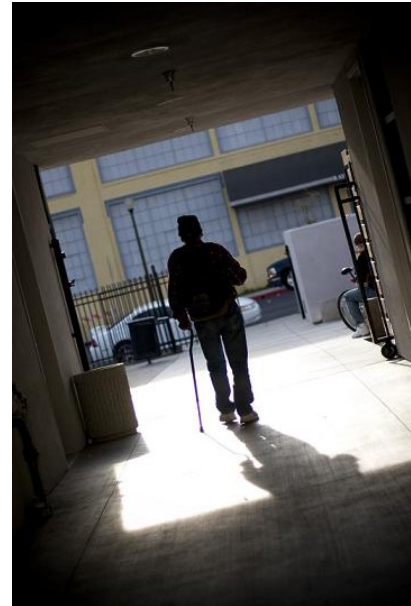
- Safe shelter with separate dorms for men and women

PROGRAM FACTS

- More than 150 homeless men and women live at the Adult Center each year
- The average length of stay is three months
- Residents meet with their case manager weekly to address the issues that led to their homelessness
- Residents receive services to improve their physical, mental and financial well-being
- All residents save 70% of their income towards future housing
- More than 60% of residents exiting our program move on to stable housing
